Test Scores

Each year midway through the academic year we administer a battery of standardized tests¹ to our Seventh and Eighth Grade students. At Camellia, we use this test to give the children an experience with standardized testing before going on to other schools. We also use it as a self-assessment tool for students and teachers. Some local high schools request test results as part of the admissions process. The CTBS is accepted by all local high schools.

The CTBS is graded independently and compares students on a national level. Here's how to read the Grade Equivalents:

- 8.5 is the expected Grade Equivalent for an Eighth Grader mid-school-year.*
- 10.1 indicates performance like a Tenth Grader in the first month of the school year.*
- 12.9 indicates performance like a Twelfth Grader in the ninth and last month of school.*
