International Student Tuition and Fee Schedule

**New International Student Application Fee:** \$100

**Enrollment Fee** for all continuing and new students: Is due at time of enrollment and is non-refundable. Enrollment is not complete until the Tuition Agreement is completed and the Enrollment Fee is paid.

Continuing Students - Family Fee (If paid by March 24, 2017)	\$290
New International Students - Family Fee	\$2,000

**International Student Tuition:\*** \$17,519  
**Tuition Protection Fee:** Is 2% of the annual tuition fee\*\* 2% of Tuition

\*International Student tutoring fees may apply, approximately \$3,000 annually per student.

\*\*Non-refundable; waived for annual payment with separate signed agreement. (See below for description of Tuition Protection Fee.)

**International Student Tutoring Fees:** This is additional tutoring beyond the daily tutoring that is included in the cost of International Student tuition. Parents must be prepared to support any additional tutoring until the school determines that the student no longer requires additional help. Current International Student tutoring needs are assessed on a case-by-case basis, and parents will be billed accordingly.

#### **Sibling Discount**

Full tuition is charged for the oldest child.  
25% discount to the second and subsequent child(ren).  
Sibling discount does not apply to preschool.

Receipt of the sibling discount is conditional upon continued attendance of the sibling(s). Should a sibling withdraw or enter during the school year, the sibling discount will be adjusted.

**\*\*Tuition Protection Fee:** The Tuition Protection Fee is **2.0% of tuition**. It is a non-refundable fee itemized on your statement. This fee is payable on the first month (which is July, if not entering mid-year) that tuition is billed for the current school year. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) who choose the one annual payment plan may elect to waive the Tuition Protection Fee. If tuition is paid in full by August 1st, prior to school starting, and the Tuition Protection Fee is waived, there will be no refund of tuition. In the event that Parent(s)/Guardian(s) decide to withdraw child(ren) from the school prior to the end of the school year, Parent(s)/Guardian(s) agree to provide the school with written notice of intent to withdraw at least 60 days prior to the withdrawal date. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) agree to pay all tuition due from date of notice to date of withdrawal. In the event that Parent(s)/Guardian(s) provide less than 60 days written notice of intent to withdraw, Parent(s)/Guardian(s) agree to pay full tuition for 60 days from the date of notice. Upon withdrawal, the remaining balance is figured on the number of weeks remaining in the school year. Partial weeks will be calculated as whole weeks. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) who withdraw a new student within the first 30 days of classes will be responsible for the payment of all non-refundable fees and tuition for the period of time attended only.

**Late Payments/Returned Payment Items:** There will be a charge of \$30 for any payment(s) returned for any reason. Any payments not received within 10 days of the payment due date will be subject to a late fee of \$20.

**Additional Fees and Charges:** In addition to tuition and the fees listed above, you may incur additional costs, including but not limited to fees for some activities, instrument rental or

purchase, and music lessons. The amount of these fees will vary and will be announced as they occur. When necessary, the school may, at parent or guardian expense, recommend and expect tutoring, external consultations, or special services which the school does not provide.

**Aftercare/Extended Care:** Extended care is an optional fee-based program for students in preschool, kindergarten, and first through eighth grade. All fees are disclosed on the Aftercare/Extended Care Contract which is incorporated in the enrollment process.

**Flutes and Recorders:** Pentatonic flutes are required for 1st grade, diatonic flutes for 3rd grade, and recorders for 6th grade. Unless otherwise requested, the school will purchase the instrument, and the cost (typically between \$40-90) will be billed to the family. If you already have the appropriate flute or recorder for your child, notify your teacher.

**Sports Uniforms:** Uniforms are required for team sports. For some sports, the school lends uniforms to players. Parents are charged the replacement cost for damaged or items that are not returned at the end of the season. For other sports, parents must purchase uniforms and proper gear for their student.

**Parent Association:** \$30.00 annual fee required by all families.
